- Response rate: 86%

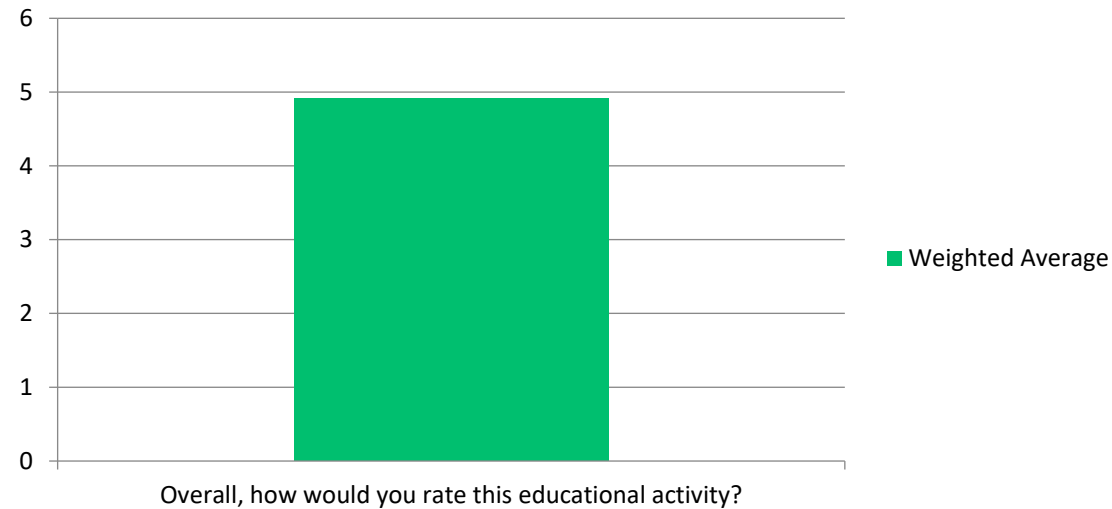
**Methods:** The evaluation was conducted through SurveyMonkey and immediately emailed to the attendees upon conclusion of the webinar.

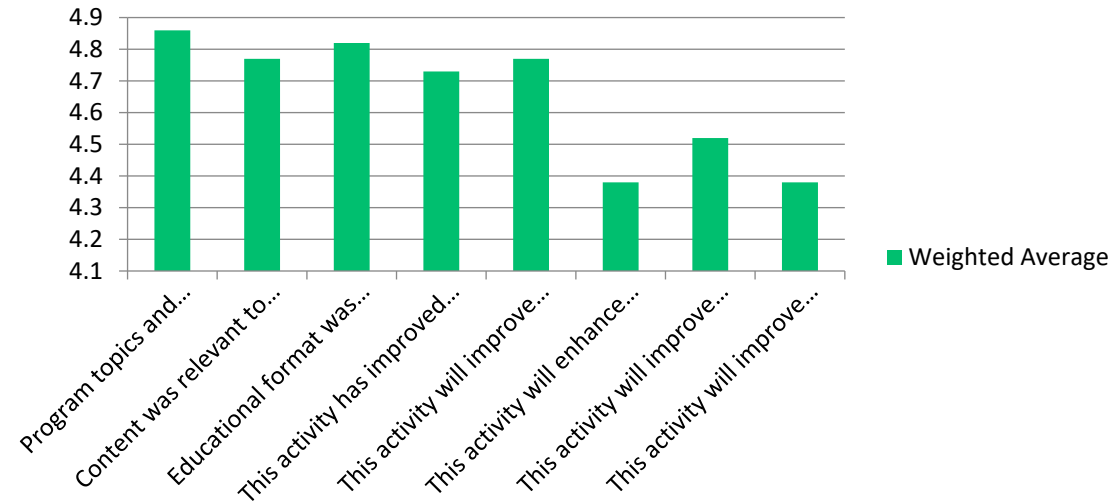

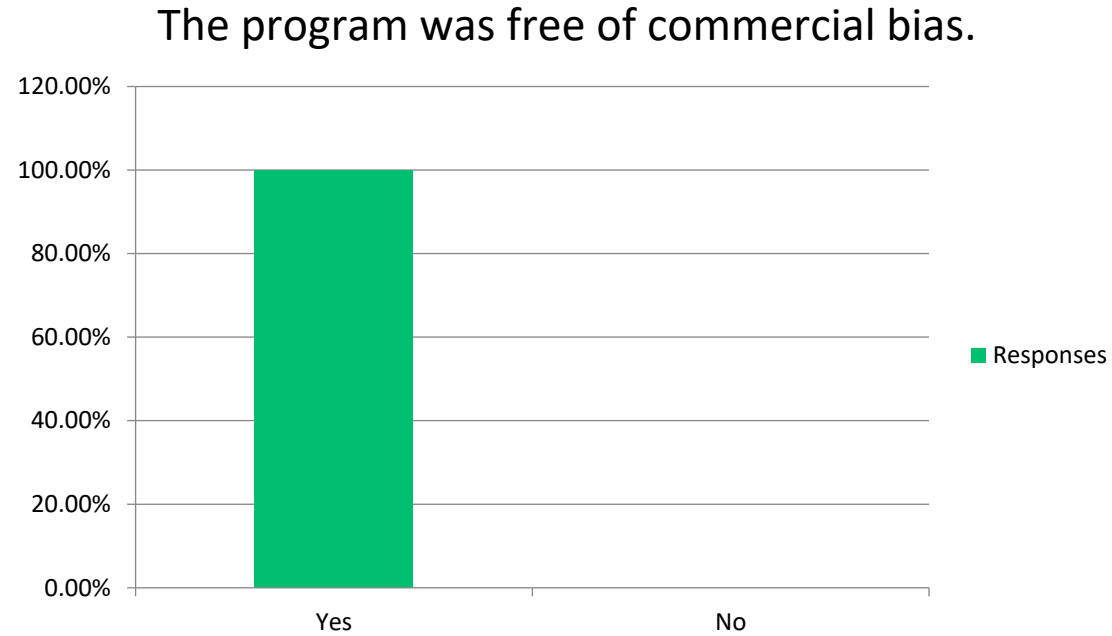
