WORKSHOP ATTIRE

Cadaver Workshop: Casual with closed-toed shoes (tennis shoes preferred). Attendees will change into scrubs at MITI. Bring a jacket if you chill easily. **If you prefer, you may wear your own scrubs to the workshop.**

CHECKING-IN FOR THE WORKSHOP

- Only pre-registered attendees and faculty are permitted.
- We will check off your name as you board the bus.
- We will check you in as you enter MITI and give you a name badge and registration materials.

HOW TO GET THERE

Transportation will be provided from the Mandalay Bay to MITI. There will also be a return bus at the conclusion of the workshop.

6:00 AM – Meet at the shuttle and bus drop off and pick up location on the Beach Level (lower level)*

6:30 AM – Bus departs

If you are late and miss the bus, you must arrange your own transportation at your own expense, e.g., taxi or Uber.
