Survey Stats:


- 52 registrations
- 28 attendees
- 7 evaluations returned
- Response rate: 25%
- Based on returns, results are accurate within ±35% at the 95% confidence level

Methods: The evaluation was conducted through SurveyMonkey and immediately emailed to the attendees upon the conclusion of the webinar.

Audience:

- 67% of the audience were physicians (2=DO, 17=MD)
- 33% of the audience were non-physicians (6=DDS, 2=Medical Students, 1=Physician Assistant)
- 88% were from the United States (1=AZ, 2=CA, 1=CO, 3=FL, 1=GA, 1=HI, 1=IL, 2=LA, 1=MA, 1=NJ, 2=NY, 1=PA, 1=RI, 1=TN, 1=TX, 4=VA, 1=WA)



- 4. Will observe the length of the nasocolumnar area more precisely using the desired normal measurements given in this ppt.

- 6. Will evaluate dental anatomy when looking at lip filler patients.
